# IBSF Para Sport World Championships 2026 Olympia Bob Run St. Moritz - Celerina, 27 January – 1 February 2026

### ORGANIZATION OF THE EVENT

The competition is organized by the Olympia Bob Run St. Moritz - Celerina.

### PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY

The competition will be carried out in accordance with International Para Bobsleigh Rules. All athletes must have a valid IBSF e-license issued by their National Federation.

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to enter athletes for event through the IBSF online system <a href="http://ibsf.sportresult.com">http://ibsf.sportresult.com</a>.

### **ENTRY DEADLINE**

The preliminary entry deadline (only the number of athletes needs to be entered) for Para Sport WCH registration is 28 days (January 30<sup>th</sup> December, 2025) before the first Team Captain's meeting, whereas all final names need to be entered 5 days (January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2026) before the first Team Captain's meeting, taking place on January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 15:00.

Please note, that from this season onwards preliminary entries (registration) are crucial for entering events! Without them, it will not be possible to register your athletes for IBSF events. Registration after deadline is not possible!

### STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Federation who attend and participate in the event do so at their own risk. The organizer will not be responsible for any loss or injuries incurred or suffered by an athlete or official in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event.

All athletes and staff are required to be covered by insurance against accidents deriving from the practice of bobsleigh and/or skeleton racing, including civil damages to third parties, for transport by ambulance, medical treatment and hospital treatment.

Prior to sliding, all athletes, coaches and staff must complete a track waiver at the Race Office.
